241 Pavement Repair Project

Nighttime Closures

241 Toll Road between 261 and 91

Beginning April 14, the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will conduct roadway work on the northbound and southbound 241 Toll Road between the 261 Toll Road and 91 freeway as part of the 241 Pavement Repair Project. Crews are repaving the roadway to smooth out existing bumps motorists encounter while traveling this stretch of the toll road.

When

Nightly, Sunday – Thursday. Closure dates will be updated and posted to [TheTollRoads.com/closures](https://www.thetollroads.com/closures).

- **Northbound 241** nighttime closures between the 261 and 91, Sunday and Monday, Apr. 14-15, 10 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- Beginning Tuesday, Apr. 16, **Southbound 241** nighttime closures between the 91 and 261, occur between 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. for the next several weeks

What to Expect

- Closures will occur either northbound or southbound, one direction only
- Project work will be done in phases through 2024
- Signage in place to assist motorists with detours

Detour for Northbound 241 Toll Road Motorists

Northbound 241 drivers will exit at Santiago Canyon Rd., turn left and head to Chapman Ave., turn right on Cannon St. and head straight to Imperial Hwy. to enter the 91 freeway.

Detour for Southbound 241 Toll Road Motorists

Motorists should take Imperial Hwy. and head towards Cannon St. Go left on Chapman Ave. and head straight to Santiago Canyon Rd. Make a slight right to enter southbound 241 or go right to enter southbound 261.
