

ABOUT THE PROJECT

The State Route 73 **Enhancement Project** is a project to remove and replace quardrails on the mainline and on- and off-ramps along the 73 Toll Road. In 2021, the first phase of the project began at the northern terminus of the 73 Toll Road. The project is entering its next phase of construction between Pacific Park Drive/ Glenwood Drive and La Paz Road. The project is expected to be completed Summer 2024.



CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

73 Toll Road Northbound and Southbound Pacific Park/Glenwood Drive to La Paz Road


The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will be starting construction on the 73 Toll Road between Pacific Park/Glenwood Drive and La Paz Road as part of the State Route 73 Enhancement Project. Crews will begin working to remove and replace the existing guardrail to enhance safety for drivers.

WHEN

Work will begin mid-September 2023 and continue through early 2024.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Mainline lane reductions
- On- and off-ramp lane reductions and full closures from Pacific Park/Glenwood Drive to La Paz Road
- Signs will be in place to assist motorists with detours
- Plan for additional travel time through the area
- This work may be loud. Nearby residents and businesses can expect nighttime construction noise and lights, including Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) required vehicle back-up alarms. Crews will work to minimize noise and impacts to all nearby communities.
